That person, according to tradition, was Nachshon, who dived into the spray without assurance the sea would split. He knew, however, that if the sea didn't recede, he would drown, and that turning back would mean certain death at the hands of the advancing Egyptian army.

Nachshon took a risk, knowing what the alternative was and realizing that human action could induce a miracle.

Those who think differently do not see the demographic juggernaut advancing on Israel.
